

management of the Pleasure Craft Operators Card unfolding into the future.


Out 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary


Browning has made significant improvements to their facilities, and for those who tent, there's a great field for you.

Canadian Coast Guard Auxiliary's Dan Savage was honoured with a national award for administrative excellence Oct. 13, which was presented by CCGA-Pacific Region president Randy Strandt.

Years of dedication to ensuring the public's safety on the water earned Canadian Coast Guard Auxiliary's Dan Savage national recognition this month.

Savage, one of Crescent Beach Unit 5's longest-serving volunteers, was honoured with a national award for administrative excellence Oct. 13.

Presented by CCGA-Pacific Region president Randy Strandt, the award recognizes Savage's work as an Advanced Rescue Training Evaluator and in implementing training standards for search and rescue personnel. Savage has been a member of the Crescent Beach crew for about 15 years. He is also president of the unit's fundraising arm, the Semiahmoo Peninsula Marine Rescue Society.

Some of our recent activities include:

- Patch for the Salmon Arm area of Chart 3053 Shuswap Lake
- New Edition of Chart 3493 Vancouver Harbour including all new multi beam bathymetry, new shoreline and other updates
- 2 patches produced for Sunshine Coast strip chart 3311 from the 3493 data. These are for the False Creek and Coal Harbour insets
- Sailing Directions BC Volume 1 now available in Print on Demand. This means that if you buy a new copy all the Notices to Mariners are incorporated
- New Edition of Chart 3860. This is for harbours on the west side of Haida Gwaii and the first chart to incorporate this new name rather than the Queen Charlotte Islands
- Planning has begun for New Charts for Haida Gwaii and we will be looking for feedback from people who navigate these waters
- Ongoing production of Notices to Mariners and updates to our corresponding Electronic Navigation Charts
- Survey activity off the West Coast of Haida Gwaii, in the Central Coast approaches to Kitimat, for many small craft harbours up and down the coast and in various other locations

#### **Government & Industry Liaison Report** 01 November 2010

The NANS/PACMAR meeting was held on the 27<sup>th</sup> of October, 2010. Items that may be of interest to recreational boaters are as follows:

#### **CCG Update:**

Installation of all new aids to navigation, including sector lights, at Second Narrows is complete. Final surveys were carried out in October; NOTMARS will follow.

There have been reports that the Cape Mudge sector light is being obscured by trees and foliage located on Indian Band land. A marine aids review has been authorized and CCG is evaluating options to restore the appropriate level of service.

#### Fraser River Bridges:

Removal of structures on the old Pitt River bridge is mostly complete.

Congestion in Essondale Channel near Port Mann has decreased from earlier levels.

Construction of the new Caraholly Range in the Port Moody area is scheduled to take place on November 15 -16, 2010.

#### **CHS Update:**

CHS has advised that the last area on the BC Coast without modern charts (ie. NAD 83 Datum, metric & bilingual) is the Haida Gwaii area. A new chart scheme is being developed and will go to stakeholders for input in 2011. CHS has no plans to effect a name change on newly printed charts until the new scheme has been implemented. Survey requirements for this undertaking are extensive and could take up to 10 years to complete.

Loran-C service has been discontinued as of October 01, 2010. Lattices will be removed from charts prior to future printing.

#### **BC Ferries Update:**

#### **Distress Flare Disposal:**

This matter was discussed briefly at the recent NANS/PACMAR meeting and will be brought up again at the upcoming Recreational Boating Advisory Council (RBAC) meeting to be held on

November 17<sup>th</sup>. At the present time, there appears to be only one option for proper flare disposal and that is Pacific Blasting in Burnaby. A recent call to Pacific Blasting confirmed that disposal costs are as follows:


Hand held flare: \$ 2.00 Parachute or rocket flare: \$ 6.00 Daylight smoke flare: \$30.00


